

Vintage Stunt Championships XXII

Five Days: March 16 – 20, 2010

Pre Registration Required.

VSC-XXII (22) will be held at Christopher Columbus Park on Silverbell Rd., Tucson, Arizona between Grant and El Camino Del Cerro (See map).

VSC Headquarters Hotel is the Riverpark Inn (520-239-2300) at 22nd Street & I-10. Access is from the frontage road going south along I-10 (see map). I-10 is now open making it easier to get to the hotel. Mention Vintage Stunt when making your reservation. To get the room rate (\$65 plus 12% tax & \$1 bed charge per night) reservations must be made by February 16th, 2010. Rates change after 2 people per room.

The Judges Meeting for all VSC judges will take place at the Riverpark Inn on Monday March 15th, 2010 from 12 noon to 1PM.

Old Time Stunt (OTS) will be held Tuesday & Wednesday, March 16 & 17, one round per day on two (2) asphalt circles. **Pilots meeting promptly at 7:30AM both days. Official flights start no later than 8:00AM.**

Classic Stunt will be held Thursday - Saturday March 18 thru 20; one round per day over three (3) days. The two highest scores will be added together for a final score and placing. **Pilots meeting promptly at 7:00AM each day. Official flights start no later than 7:30AM.**

Classic Stunt Appearance Judging will be held Wednesday (March 18th) starting promptly at **4:30PM at the Riverpark Inn** (See map).

ARF's, ARC's, Purchased, or Borrowed Classic models can compete but receive a zero (0) for appearance.

Old Time Ignition will be held Tuesday and Wednesday, March 16 & 17 on **Grass**. **Pilots meeting promptly at 7:30AM each day.**

VSC Banquet will be held on Saturday night March 20th at the Riverpark Inn 350 S. Freeway (See map). **Cash Bar at 5:00PM and Dinner served at 6:30PM.** This is a sit down dinner plus award presentations.

Attention: Midnight Friday March 5th, 2010. By this date we need to know if you are attending VSC 22. Jim's mailing address is on the Registration form below. Download of Registration Form available at [www.ccmasonline.org]. Three addresses and phone numbers are provided below along with e:mail addresses. Registration can be done in one of two ways. 1) Send in the registration with payment of fees when there is no doubt that it will arrive well before the deadline. 2) Call or e:mail one of the listed people below, when time is short, and mail the form and fees the same day you call or e:mail. Please note that as the deadline of March 5, 2010 gets closer there are fewer options available to you. **If we do not know that you plan to attend VSC 22 by either of these two methods by midnight of March 5, 2010, you will have to wait until the following year and enter VSC 23.** The Banquet sign-up is held open by Jim Hoffman until after the start of VSC (the 16th). If you want to attend the banquet and have not signed-up, check with Jim at the flying site by **10AM, Wednesday March 17th**. Our policy is to return your entry fees if you have registered and can not make it; let us know. Refunds for the banquet are handled by Jim Hoffman **and may not be made after 10AM Wednesday March 17th**.

The banquet for VSC 22 will be Mexican food served buffet style. The Banquet fee is \$28 per Person.

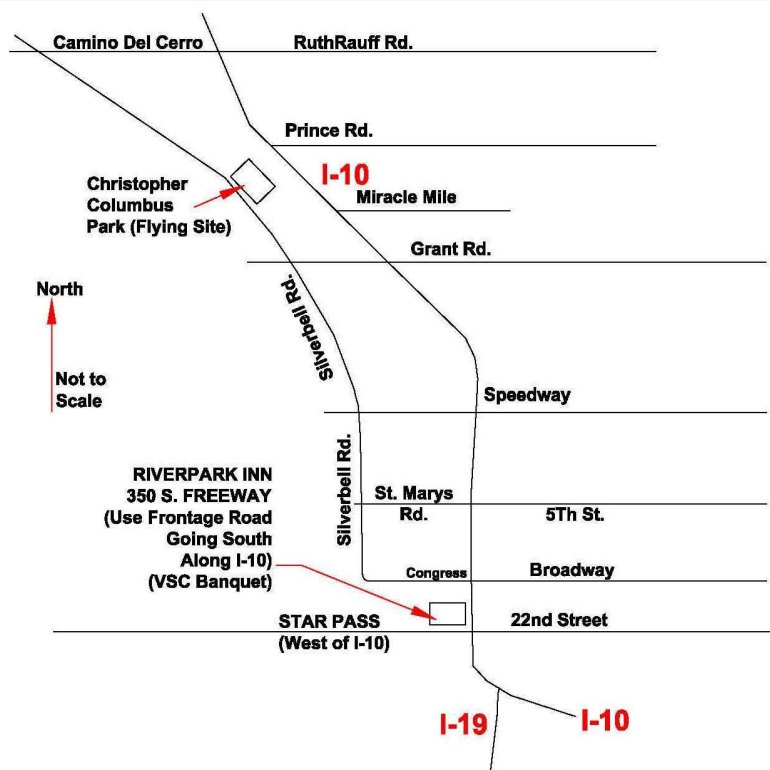

1) All contestants entering VSC are required to sign the entry form where indicated. A builder of the model rule, as it applies to VSC, is included in the current Competition Regulations for VSC and is posted on the Cholla Chopper Web Site. Please read it if you have not already done so. Pull Test for Old Time and Classic Stunt will be per the 2009 – 2010 AMA rules for Control Line Precision Aerobatics (10g pull test based on the weight of the model). Scoring for Classic will be per the 2007 – 2008 rules for Control Line Precision Aerobatics. This means pattern points will be included in the scoring.

2) During the two official flight days for Old Time and Old Time Ignition (March 16 & 17), the two unused grass circles will be reserved for Old Time and Old Time Ignition practicing until 10:00AM. No Classic practice flights will be permitted on these two circles (at the contest site) before 10:00AM Tuesday & Wednesday unless the ignition stunt competition ends early. If ignition stunt ends early, that grass circle is open for practice to any and all competitors. The asphalt circle not used for Old Time competition (Circle #1) is reserved for Classic practice both days of Old Time Competition until 10:00AM. After 10:00AM all the unused circles are open for practice to any and all competitors. The rules for Old Time Stunt are unchanged.

3) There will be three days of Classic competition at VSC 22; one round each day using all three asphalt circles. The two highest scores will be added together for the final score and placing. Classic Stunt official flights will start no later than 7:30AM each day (Thursday - Saturday; March 18 - 20) with the pilots meeting taking place at 7:00AM each day. Because of the early start the Classic flight order will be posted at the Riverpark Inn during appearance judging Wednesday March 17th.

4) The Dinner and Awards Banquet will take place Saturday night March 20th at the Riverpark Inn located at 350 S. Freeway (I-10 at 22nd Street). Cash Bar at 5:00PM; Dinner is scheduled for 6:30PM.

5) The Cholla Chopper web site is: www.ccmasonline.org. Important information is posted there and can be printed, downloaded, or both. You should visit the web site and carefully read all the information provided. Call Robin Sizemore (520-749-4434), Lou Wolgast 520-479-1812, or Jim Hoffman (480-897-0630) if you do not have internet access.

6) If you plan to stay in Christopher Columbus Park over night, fill in the State and License Plate number of your RV, Camper, etc.; and the State if different from the address. We need to know this information so that we can provide it to Tucson Parks and Rec. which will keep the authorities from knocking on your camper door at 11PM.
