I decided to get "field organized" once and for all by organizing my stuff for the flight line, the pits, and field repair. The insulated square carry bag has all my stuff to get a plane ready to fly: lines, handles, fuel and the heavy starter. The black bag from Home Depot has four snap lid boxes and outside carry pockets with all the spare props, tools and junk you never need, expect when you do. The flight line box with carry handle has a separate compartment for the heavy starter in the bottom with glow starter, starter battery, chicken stick, tachometer, wind gage, primer bottle, starter battery volt meter, glow clips, and spare glow plugs within
